3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

- prepare a surface of planks to construct the roof structure on, take care of setting out;
- sharpen and maintain hand and power tools;
- prepare on-site auxiliary structures (rails, ladders, etc.);
- take part in the assembly of couple roof structures, traditional and modern roof structures with single post or several posts, or complex roof structures (tower, sawtooth roof, etc.);
- take part in the assembly of both simple and complex strutted roofs and suspension structures;
- prepare, fit, and demolish timber slabs;
- take part in the construction of single- or multi-storey timber structures;
- assemble and strike both traditional and modern timber or composite structure formwork (walls, smooth or ribbed slabs, lintel beam, ring beam, etc.);
- take part in the assembly and striking of modern steel formwork and steel props;
- prepare the structural parts of light-weight working platforms, assembly and ladder scaffolding of timber structure (small-size buck, two-meter buck, ladder with footing, etc.);
- take part in the erection and demolition of modern tubular scaffolding and module scaffolding of metal structure;
- take part in the erection and demolition of auxiliary timber, metal and composite scaffolding structures (access ladders, stands for storing and transporting materials, provisional scaffolding, etc.);
- take part in the erection and demolition of heavy scaffolding of timber structure (stone setting, elevator stand, etc.);
- take part in the erection and demolition of both traditional and modern strutting structures, life-saving props, and falsework;
- make simple furniture (timber table, bench, shelf, etc.), wooden fences, gates, frames and jambs, external and internal coverings, timber floors, attic stairs, roof ladders, access ladders;
- do the fungus- and flame-proofing of timber.

The basis of the grading system is a list of vocational and examination requirements compiled in accordance with uniform criteria and structure, issued in the form of legal regulation that includes the following:

- identification number and description of the vocational qualification as specified in OKJ and the relevant FEOR number,
- school and vocational prequalification required for the start of the training, aptitude and vocational competence requirements and prescribed practice,
- the most typical occupation or activity accessible to the holder of the vocational qualification certificate, the short job description, and the list of related vocational qualifications,
- the duration of the training required for the vocational qualification; maximum number of hours; the ratio of theoretical and practical training; the number of vocational training classes in the vocational training school; the duration of initial training period; the possibility of organising a grade examination assessing the efficiency of practical training,
- occupational requirements of vocational qualification,
- requirements pertaining to vocational examination.

The vocational and examination requirements will be classified by the occupational group committees of the National Qualification Register (OKJ) and by the National Council for Vocational Training, and subsequently they will be issued in the form of legal regulations.
