3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

- A typical holder of the certificate is able to:
- prepare the batter board, perform staking out
- sharpen and maintain hand tools and machine tools;
- build auxiliary structures (guards, ladders, etc.) on construction sites;
- take part in the construction of simple empty roof trusses, traditional and modern single and multiple, complex roof structures (tower saw tooth, etc.);
- take part in the construction of simple and compound section trusses and hanging trusses;
- construct, place and disassemble wooden floors;
- take part in the construction of single or multistorey wooden structures;
- construct and disassemble traditional and modern wooden or mixed structures (wall, surface or bridging floors, trimmer beams, crowning, etc.);
- take part in the assembling and disassembling of modern metal sheetings, metal floor-supporting structures;
- construct the structural parts of wooden, light work stands, repair stands, scale stands (small stand, two-metre stand, ladder with bedplate etc.);
- take part in the assembling and disassembling of modern tube scaffolding and metal modular scaffolding;
- take part in the assembling and disassembling of wooden, metal and mixed structure auxiliary structures (access boards, material storage and conveyor structures, temporary structures, etc.);
- take part in the assembling and disassembling of wooden heavy scaffolding (stone placing, lifting, etc.);
- take part in the assembling and disassembling of traditional and modern propping structures, emergency propping structures, relieving propping structures;
- construct simple furnishings (desks, benches, shelves, etc.), wooden fences, gates, plankcases, jambs, external and internal floorings, boardings, loft stairs, roof-ladders, access ladders;
- perform the fungus- and flame-proofing of wooden materials.

The basis of the grading system is a list of vocational and examination requirements compiled in accordance with uniform criteria and structure, issued in the form of legal regulation that includes the following:

- identification number and description of the vocational qualification as specified in OKJ and the relevant FEOR number,
- school and vocational prequalification required for the start of the training, aptitude and vocational competence requirements and prescribed practice,
- the most typical occupation or activity accessible to the holder of the vocational qualification certificate, the short job description, and the list of related vocational qualifications,
- the duration of the training required for the vocational qualification; maximum number of hours; the ratio of theoretical and practical training; the number of vocational training classes in the vocational training school; the duration of initial training period; the possibility of organising a grade examination assessing the efficiency of practical training,
- occupational requirements of vocational qualification,
- requirements pertaining to vocational examination.

The vocational and examination requirements will be classified by the occupational group committees of the National Qualification Register (OKJ) and by the National Council for Vocational Training, and subsequently they will be issued in the form of legal regulations.
